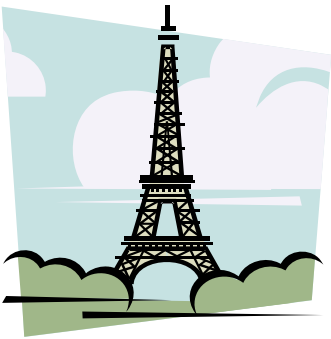

GLOBAL LANGUAGES PROGRAM

Most students here at the Three Village Central School District begin their study of a second language in grade 7. We offer study of French, Italian, and Spanish this year starting at the Introductory level and continued study of the those languages and German as well in grade 8.

All students must begin their study in the Introduction level. After this year students will be placed in either a regular (level I) or honors sequence (level A) of study for the following year. This placement is based on the following criteria as stipulated in the Program of Study book: teacher recommendation, a 95 or better average for Introductory study and Terra Nova reading and language scores of 96 or higher.

Students who are placed in Honors level language classes (levels A and B) are required to maintain an average of 85 or higher to remain in this challenging level of study. Additionally, students who enter level B must remain through at least level C honors at WM.

All language teachers are available for extra help. Students should contact teachers for times and days. All language teachers are also available for assistance 2 days out of the 6 day cycle. **THE STUDENT HELP SCHEDULE WILL BE POSTED IN SEPTEMBER.**



New York State has eliminated the Proficiency Exam in languages effective 2011. This exam was given upon completion of level I or A study and served as the initial benchmark for students' progress in language study. The Three Village CSD will be developing a final exam for these courses which reflects the curricula for the year.

New York State has eliminated Regents Exams in global languages as well. Our district will be developing a comparable assessment which will grant students the appropriate Regents level credit for language study on their transcripts.

NATIONAL LANGUAGE HONOR SOCIETY

We operate a chapter of the National Language Honor Society at the 9th grade level for those students who have met the criteria. Participation in this society is based on sustained academic excellence in language learning over a three year period of study. This society is run as an extracurricular club and those students meeting the criteria for entrance are invited to join in the fall. The criteria are available on the Global Languages website

and are: a 90 or higher average for the study of a language in grades 7, 8 and the first 2 quarters of grade 9. The activities of this club culminate with an induction ceremony which takes place on Tuesday April 24, 2012 at 7:00 pm.
