**T**he Three Village School District offers a **Saturday Enrichment Program** for students in grades K-6.

The program includes classes that enrich our curriculum and provide opportunities for creative expression. Classes meet for 55 minutes each week, beginning at 9:30, 10:30, or 11:30 a.m., December 10-March 10, at R.C. Murphy Junior High School. **Registration is MAIL-IN ONLY. Enrollment is limited and is on a first-come, first-served basis.** This program is self-supporting, and therefore funded by tuition and fees. Unless noted, tuition for each class is \$65 for District residents, \$75 for non-residents. **Please submit a separate check for each class.** Materials fees indicated will be collected **by the instructor** at the first class. **All tuition is nonrefundable**, unless a class is canceled due to insufficient registration. **There will be no schedule changes once classes begin.**

Parents are requested to escort their children to their first class and pick them up after the last class. You may be asked to show identification when picking up your child. Please note that only parents or an authorized designee can pick up children. Parents are not permitted to remain in the room during classes. We ask that parents leave the building and pick up their child at the end of their classes. Program staff will assist students in moving from class to class. It is helpful to use a name tag listing K-1 students' names and class schedules. This will help the staff escort the students to the appropriate classrooms. **Children are not permitted in the school unless registered for a course at that hour.**

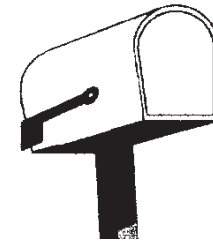
