## 7<sup>th</sup> GRADE Introduction to Language

Students beginning a language take the introductory level of the language of their choice\*:

**INTRO COURSE = one half of LEVEL 1**

\* Courses will only be offered if a minimum enrollment is maintained as established by district administration and the BOE. Students will be asked to provide alternate choices 2-5.

\* Required for HS graduation

## 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Level I – Regents sequence

- Second half of level I – continuation of Intro course
- NY State Checkpoint A
- Course culminates in *NY State Proficiency Exam* (tests basic proficiency in language, required for graduation, recorded on HS transcript)
- Successful completion of level I goes to level II

# 8<sup>th</sup> grade level A Honors

- This is the beginning of an Honors level sequence of language study which requires significant motivation and application on the part of the student\*
- This course completes Checkpoint A and begins Checkpoint B
- Students are required to remain in the Honors program through the completion of level C (10<sup>th</sup> grade at WM)
- Course culminates in *NY State Proficiency Exam* (tests basic proficiency in language, required for graduation, recorded on transcript ) AND a district level final exam
- Successful completion of level A goes to level B

\*Students must maintain a grade of 85+ during the first 15 weeks or he/she will be moved to Level I

# 9<sup>th</sup> grade overview

## level II or level B Honors

- 9<sup>th</sup> GRADE Level II
- Continuation of Regents level sequence
- Beginning of Checkpoint B
- Assessment: District final exam

- 9<sup>th</sup> GRADE Level B
- Continuation of Honors level sequence
- Completion of Checkpoint B
- Assessment: NYS Regents exam\*, district level final

\*REQUIRED for HS Graduation, recorded on HS transcript

## **9<sup>th</sup> Grade Level II – Regents sequence**

- **NY State Checkpoint B – begins**
- **Course culminates in district final exam**
- **Course required for graduation**
- **Successful completion of level II goes to level III at WM**

# 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Level B Honors

- This is the continuation of an Honors level sequence of language study which requires significant motivation and application on the part of the student\*
  - Completion of Checkpoint B
  - Course culminates in NY State Regents Exam (required for graduation, recorded on transcript) and district level final exam
  - Students in the Honors program must continue study in this language through successful completion of level C at WM
- \*Students must maintain a grade of 85+ during the first 15 weeks or be moved to Level II
