School Supplies

Personal items to be labeled with child's name and room number 115:

- \_\_\_ 3 marble composition notebooks
- \_\_\_ 1 sturdy folder with horizontal pockets inside
- \_\_\_ 1 plastic ruler (marked in both 12 inches and 30 centimeters)
- \_\_\_ Plastic zippered pencil pouch (not a hard plastic box)
- \_\_\_ 1 box of crayons (16 or 24 count)
- \_\_\_ Scissors (child size with a blunt tip)
- \_\_\_ 1 manual pencil sharpener
- \_\_\_ 1 large eraser
- \_\_\_ Smock in a zippered plastic baggie
- \_\_\_ 1 set of personal earphones/earbuds in a zippered plastic baggie
- \_\_\_ 2 black fine tip dry erase markers (low odor please)
- \_\_\_ 1 gallon size and 1 quart size zippered plastic baggie

Community supplies that do not need to be labeled:

- \_\_\_ 24 sharpened yellow #2 pencils
- \_\_\_ 1 set of colored pencils
- \_\_\_ 1 set of broad and/or fine magic markers
- \_\_\_ glue sticks (6 large or 10 small)
- \_\_\_ 1 box of tissues
- \_\_\_ 1 box of baby wipes
- \_\_\_ 1 package of 3x3 sticky notes
- \_\_\_ 1 package of white 3x5 index cards

Items to have at home for homework assignments:

- Crayons or other coloring tools
- Scissors
- Glue sticks
