

VOTER REGISTRATION

Personal Registration for the Budget Vote and School Board Elections takes place

April 1, 2010 to May 5, 2010 in the Office of the District Clerk, at the North Country

Administration Building, 100 Suffolk Avenue, Stony Brook, NY from 9:00 am to 11:30 am

and 1:15 pm to 3:15 pm on days when school is in session. Voter Registration will also be

held on Wednesday, May 5, 2010 at Ward Melville High School, Setauket NY from 9:00 am

to 7:00 pm. If you are a resident of this District who is registered to vote with the Suffolk

County Board of Elections and have voted in any District Vote since January 1, 2006, you

are entitled to vote without further registration. All other persons who wish to vote must

register.

ABSENTEE BALLOTS

Applications for absentee ballots will be obtainable during school business hours from the

District Clerk beginning April 30, 2010 and must be submitted to the District Clerk by

4:00 pm on May 11, 2010 if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter. If the ballot is to be

delivered in person to the voter, the completed application must be received by the District

Clerk no later than 4:00 pm on May 17, 2010. Completed absentee ballots must be returned

to the office of the District Clerk no later than 5:00 pm on May 18, 2010.

NOMINATING PETITIONS FOR THE BOARD OF EDUCATION ELECTION

Completed nominating petitions must be submitted no later than 5:00 pm on April 19, 2010

at the office of the District Clerk. There are no exceptions to this deadline *School Education*
