Dear Mount Families,

We are so excited to welcome your children back to Mount in a few short days. As we prepare for the first day of school, I would like to take this opportunity to make you aware of some changes to our arrival and dismissal procedures.

We are hoping that most of our children utilize the transportation provided by the district each day. Your child's bus stop and estimated pick up and drop off time can be found on the Parent Portal. Please use these times as estimates and be prepared for drivers running early and late the first few days. For the first week, new students and kindergarteners will disembark busses first, with the assistance of staff, until they get acclimated to walking into the building on their own.

For families who will be dropping off and picking up their child, we will no longer be utilizing the placards. Morning arrival will remain the same. Arrival will begin at 9:15am. A line will form around the parking lot. When your car gets to the curb by the security entrance, your child should get out of the car on the passenger side and enter the building. Security will be outside to assist in this process.

Dismissal in the afternoon will be held in the cafeteria. If your child is being picked up, please write a note to your child's teacher indicating their dismissal plan. Please park your car and come into the building to pick up your child. Parents will be permitted into the building at 3:30 to pick up their child. Please be sure to have photo ID.
