- Please remember to bring your identification with you when you pick your child up from school. We need to identify the person picking up the student to ensure that they are allowed to pick the child up, based on your emergency contact information. Please note that only those designated individuals who you have listed as emergency contacts will be allowed to pick up your child. To ensure safety and accuracy, please notify your child's teacher, in writing, about your dismissal plans.
- ➤ To ensure our arrival and dismissal is as safe and efficient as possible, we are returning to pre-COVID procedures for parent drop-off and pick-up. The procedures we had in place during the pandemic were for emergency purposes only. We will send out additional correspondence with details regarding our 2022-23 arrival and dismissal procedures.

- **September 9**<sup>th</sup>- 9/11 Remembrance Day. We will honor 9/11 with our flag planting tradition. We ask that you wear red, white and blue on this date.
- September 20th and 21st- Picture Day.
