


CERAMICS

course syllabus • 2021-2022


COURSE DESCRIPTION

Ceramics introduces students to ceramic three-dimensional works of art that are both decorative and functional. Students will learn a variety of hand building techniques, including slab rolled clay, coil and subtractive sculpture. We will also cover wheel throwing: where students will experience loading and unloading and firing a kiln. Various glaze techniques will aso be introduced.

Suggested materials



SKETCHBOOK (no larger than 8.5x11")



T-SHIRT/ARTICLE OF CLOTHING (this will act as your smock)



NEWSPAPER (always helpful if you have any lying around your house)



PLASTIC SHOPPING BAGS (or dry cleaning bags—these will be used when we work with clay to keep the clay from drying out)

Depending on what projects we decide to do as a class, you may be required to bring in certain materials. If you ever have any problem obtaining these materials, please let the teacher know and they will do their best to help you out.

- Cell phones: must be used in a respectful and professional manner. If the phone becomes a distraction, I will confiscate the phone.




All work that you create in this class will be photographed and made into a digital portfolio, that can be used for art shows, websites, and collage portfolios.








GRADING POLICY

Campus google classroom
