COURSE DESCRIPTION

Crafts is a half year course that introduces students to both 2-D and 3-D design. This course provides an introduction to the basic craft areas of ceramics, mosaics, glass, stencil techniques and sculpture. We may explore several types of media including: clay, glass, natural materials, recycled materials, fiber arts, drawing, and printmaking.

If you are absent, it is your responsibility to make up any missed work.

LATE PROJECTS
