- We will use Teacher Reacher, an online conference manager system for the Parent Teacher Conference Night.
- In order to familiarize yourself with the Teacher Reacher program, parents will be able to create an account and link their student(s) to their account beginning November 10th. The registration window for conference appointments opens on November 16th at 8:00 AM and closes on November 27th at 5:00 PM.
