Dear Parent/Guardian,

As of July 1, 2018, **New York State law requires a health examination for all students entering a school district for the first time and when entering Pre-K or K, 1st, 3rd, 5th, 7th, 9th and 11th grades.** A dental certificate which states your child has been seen by a dentist or dental hygienist is requested at the same time.

- A copy of the health examination must be provided to the school within 30 days from when your child first starts school and/or when your child starts Pre-K or K, 1st, 3rd, 5th, 7th, 9th, and 11th grades.
- If your child has an appointment for an exam during the current school year that is after the first 30 days of school, please send written appointment details to the Health Office.
- Please review immunization records with your child's health care provider to ensure that they are compliant with annual requirements. You can view the records currently on file in the Health Office on the Parent Portal>Health Section.

The ***Required NYS School Health Examination Form*** must be used to record the health exam results. The form is located on Three Village Central School District Website, - click on District, click on Medical Forms & Health Info., click on District Health Forms.

It is recommended that copies be made of all completed forms, for your own records, prior to submitting them to the health office.

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NYS Mandates Health Screenings for Vision, Hearing and Scoliosis. Your child's health care provider must perform these screenings and document the results on the *Required NYS School Health Exam Form*. See the requirements below. **If the screening information is not completed on the health form, the School Nurse will perform the mandated screenings during the school year.**

When screenings are completed by the school nurse, results can be viewed on the parent portal – click on “health office screening”. A letter is sent home if your child needs a follow up with a health care provider. Please call the Health Office if you have any questions or concerns.

Vision

- Distance and near acuity for all newly entering students and students in Pre-K or Kindergarten, and Grades 1, 3, 5, 7 and 11.
- Color perception screening for all newly entering students regardless of grade.

Hearing

- Hearing screening for all newly entering students regardless of grade and students in Pre-K or Kindergarten, and Grades 1, 3, 5, 7 and 11.

Scoliosis

- Scoliosis screening for all girls in grades 5 and 7, and boys in grade 9

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
