Dear Parent/Guardian,

As of July 1, 2018, New York State law requires a health examination for all students entering a school district for the first time and when entering Pre-K or K, 1st, 3rd, 7th, 9th and 11th grades. A dental certificate which states your child has been seen by a dentist or dental hygienist is requested at the same time.

- A copy of the health examination must be provided to the school within 30 days from when your child first starts school and/or when your child starts Pre-K or K, 1st, 3rd, 5th, 7th, 9th, and 11th grades.
- If your child has an appointment for an exam during the current school year that is after the first 30 days of school, please send written appointment details to the Health Office.
- Please review immunization records with your child's health care provider to ensure that they are compliant
 with annual requirements. You can view the records currently on file in the Health Office on the Parent
 Portal>Health Section.

The NYS required form, which is located on the district website under health/medical forms, must be used to record health exam results. We suggest making copies of all completed forms, for your own records, prior to submitting them to the health office.

Dear Parent/Guardian:

The Three Village Central School District's School Health Services Program supports your student's academic success by promoting health in the school setting. One way that we provide care for your student is by performing health screenings that are mandated by the State of New York.

During the school year, the following screenings are require to be performed at school, if this information is not completed on the health exam submitted to the school Health Office.

Vision

- Distance and near acuity for all newly entering students and students in Pre-K or Kindergarten, and Grades 1, 3, 5, 7 and 11.
- Color perception screening for all newly entering students regardless of grade.

Hearing

• Hearing screening for all newly entering students regardless of grade and students in Pre-K or Kindergarten, and Grades 1, 3, 5, 7 and 11.

Scoliosis

Scoliosis screening for all girls in grades 5 and 7, and boys in grade 9

When screenings are completed by your school nurse, you can view the results on the parent portal. At the bottom left side menu there is a link to the "health office screening". A letter is sent home if your student needs a follow up with a health care provider. Please call the Health Office if you have any questions or concerns.
