The Three Village Central School District's School Health Services Program supports your student's academic success by promoting health in the school setting. One way that we provide care for your student is by performing health screenings that are mandated by the State of New York.

During the school year, the following screenings are required to be performed at school, if this information is not completed on the health exam submitted to the school Health Office.

## Vision

- Distance and near acuity for all newly entering students and students in Pre-K or Kindergarten, and Grades 1, 3, 5, 7 and 11.
- Color perception screening for all newly entering students regardless of grade.

## Hearing

 Hearing screening for all newly entering students regardless of grade and students in Pre-K or Kindergarten, and Grades 1, 3, 5, 7 and 11.

## Scoliosis

• Scoliosis screening for all girls in grades 5 and 7, and boys in grade 9.

When screenings are completed by your school nurse, you can view the results on the parent portal. At the bottom left side menu there is a link to the "health office screening." A letter is sent home if your student needs a follow-up with a health care provider. Please call the Health Office if you have any questions or concerns.
