Three Village Central School District is excited to announce the Microsoft Student Advantage program. Due to an existing enterprise agreement with Microsoft, students are now able to download and install Microsoft Office desktop applications on their home computers and/or devices for FREE!

Note to Parents and Students:

This entitlement provides students access to the commercially available Microsoft software products. The software is the same as if you purchased it directly from your local retail or App store. As such, the district's content filters and Internet security services are not associated with your home computers or personal devices. Students are also able to save to Microsoft's OneDrive, a cloud-based system for file access and sharing.

Who is eligible? All active Three Village students.

What happens when a student graduates or withdraws from Three Village CSD?

Once a student has left the district, their Microsoft Office subscription will end.

What software can the student download?

Eligible students are able to download Microsoft Office applications on up to 5 devices (PC, Mac, and/or mobile device). These applications include Word, Excel, PowerPoint, OneNote*, Access*, and Publisher*.



Download and Installation Instructions for Students

Microsoft Student Advantage allows a student to download and install Microsoft Office on up to 5 computers or devices. Below are the instructions to complete this download and installation.

- 1) Check to make sure that your home computer or device meets the minimum requirements. Please review these requirements here http://products.office.com/en-US/office-system-requirements
- 2) Obtain User Info Log into the Campus Portal to locate your student user name and password for your Microsoft 365 account. Please Note: this account is NOT associated with an e-mail account, it is only for use in the Microsoft website. https://icampus.3villagecsd.k12.ny.us/campus/portal/threevillage.jsp
- 3) Open your web browser (such as Microsoft Internet Explorer, Firefox, Safari or Chrome) and navigate to https://login.microsoftonline.com/
- 4) Enter your username and password (located in the Infinite Campus Portal).



5) You are now logged in to Office 365, which provides access to download and install Microsoft Office 2013 software. Locate the heading that says "Install the latest version of Office". When you are ready, click the "Install" button and the installation will automatically take place. Follow the on-screen instructions and you will have the Microsoft Office 2013 software installed.
