Dear Incoming Kindergarten Families,

I would like to take this opportunity to welcome you to the Three Village Kindergarten Screening Process. Although this is an unprecedented time in our society, we are planning to make your child's kindergarten experience a pleasant one, while adhering to the guidelines set forth by our governor.

Kindergarten Screening will take place at **Nassakeag Elementary School** on June 14th and 15th in the Library. You will be notified of your child's scheduled appointment time. If you are unable to keep this appointment, we kindly ask that you contact the Main Office at your earliest convenience. Please enter the building using the **University Drive** entrance. Be sure to complete the necessary forms which can be found on our website under Kindergarten Registration. We ask that you email or fax these documents to us prior to your child's appointment, as we are unable to accept paper documents on the day of the screening. Our screening process is a time for our staff members to spend some time with your child, while the parent/guardian meets with a school psychologist/social worker and nurse to discuss any social/emotional or health concerns. We respectfully ask that you adhere to the following guidelines so that your child's screening experience can be a successful one.

- Be prompt and adhere to your appointment time
- Enter the building using the University Drive entrance where you will be asked to show ID to the Security Guard on duty.
- Only 1 adult can escort their child to screening
- Please refrain from bringing siblings or any other family members
- Parents and children must wear personal protective equipment
- We will follow recommended CDC guidelines when you and your child enter the building
- Please adhere to socially distant signs/decals

Your child's screening results will available through the Parent Portal in the beginning of August. We look forward to meeting your child as they embark on this exciting journey to becoming a life-long learner. Thank you in advance for your support and cooperation.
