Re: Grades 8 & 9 Course Verification Process

Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s):

Throughout the winter, counselors met with all 7th and 8th grade students to assist in selecting elective course choices for the 2022-2023 school year. In addition, your child's current academic teachers have carefully considered appropriate course placement of each student. Please login to the portal beginning **Tuesday, May 10th at 9:00AM** and review the course list for accuracy.

In the event that you believe your child qualifies for placement in a course at a different level, you may appeal the indicated placement. If you would like assistance with your decision or in understanding the appeals process, you may consult with your child's subject area teacher or guidance counselor.

Should you choose to appeal for a change in a course placement, please send an email to murphyappeals@3villagecsd.org with the following information by **Friday, June 10th**:

- State the reason(s) you believe your child's placement should be changed and any additional information, which you believe, is pertinent to a change in placement.
- We will also consider report cards from previous years.

Each appeal will be carefully reviewed by building administration, and parents will receive an email notification of the school's decision on or before **Friday, June 17th**. We trust this process will serve to resolve any placement issues for the 2022-2023 school year. Please review the Program of Study, found on the school website, for course maintenance criteria information.

Please note that your child's placement may change throughout the school year. Adjustments may be made in course level based upon evaluation of your child's academic effort and performance.

Should you wish to change your child's elective course(s), please email the **Murphy Guidance Office** at mursched@3villagecsd.org by **Friday, June 10th**. Junior High School student schedules, which include courses, assigned teachers, class periods, and room numbers, will be posted on the portal on or about **Monday, August 15th**.
