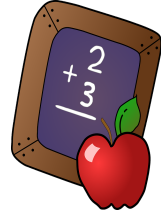

Tests/Quizzes:

Assessing student progress is a crucial part of learning that helps us to identify student areas of strength and weakness. All grades will be posted on the parent portal.

- ★ If absent from school on the day of a test or a quiz, students will be required to complete the assessment as soon as possible.

Classwork:

We will be working on many assignments in class throughout the course of the year. All of these assignments will be posted on google classroom.

Preparedness and Participation:

This grade includes bringing a charged Chromebook to class every day as well as participating during the lesson by taking notes and answering questions. Students will have 2 "Oh, no!" days where they will NOT be penalized or lose points for not bringing in a charged chromebook; however, after the 2 "Oh, no!" days, points are deducted from their preparedness and participation average.

Homework:

Homework can be handed in late for half-credit up until the end of the quarter.
