Mr. Diviney called the meeting open at 6:10 pm.

BOARD PRESIDENT STATEMENT Mr. Diviney stated that Mrs. Peritore could not be at the Board Meeting due to the death of a family member and conveyed condolences to Mrs. Peritore and her family on behalf of the

Mr. Diviney read a statement regarding the recent disclosure of confidential material from the District's labor attorney, Gregory Guercio.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION Debra Garnier, employee and clerical unit president, presented comments regarding the clerical

unit's contract.

Jake Welde, student, presented comments regarding the IG Program.

Elizabeth Kotseas DeLucia, District resident, presented comments regarding the disclosure of the confidential memo and the TVTA contract.

BOARD RECOGNITION

Mr. Lederer acknowledged Ms. Mendelson's receipt of a certificate from the New York State School Boards Association for her participation in a recent workshop and her continued efforts in becoming an informed school board member.

Mr. Diviney acknowledged the Gelinas and Murphy Junior High's Science Olympiad Teams participation at the New York State Tournaments. The Gelinas team placed second and will go on to compete in the National Tournament with Ward Melville High School's Science Olympiads and Murphy placed third.

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

Upon recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, be it RESOLVED that the Memorandum of Agreement – Contract, between the Three Village Central School District Teacher's Association and the Board of Education be approved and authorizes the Board President and the Interim Superintendent of Schools to sign the agreement upon ratification by the membership of the unit.

Motion was made by Mr. Kornreich, seconded by Dr. Whitney, opposed by Mr. McIntosh, and carried by a 4-1-0 vote to approve the resolution as presented.

Mr. Carlson made a brief presentation outlining the savings to be incurred by the contract modification.

Dr. Whitney and Mr. McIntosh presented comments regarding the contract modification.

2011-2012 BUDGET SUMMATION AND REVIEW

Mr. Carlson presented the 2011-2012 Budget Summation and Review:

Summary

- Revised budget total \$174,585,266
 - Increase of \$7,472,580 over the 2010-2011 school budget
 - 4/5% budget to budget increase
- Tax Levy \$127,970,641
 - Increase of \$4,740,051
 - 3/8% tax levy increase
 - Any change in assessments would cause tax rate % increase to be different than tax levy % increase.

Mr. McIntosh motioned to fully restore the Transition Coordinator position and the Math program by cutting an additional \$100,000 from the security budget and adding \$18,000 from the general budget, seconded by Mr. Diviney and carried by a 5-0-0 vote to approve the 2011-2012 Budget as amended.

ADOPTION OF 2011-2012 RECOMMENDED BUDGET AND PROPERTY TAX REPORT CARD Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools be it RESOLVED that a budget in the amount of \$174,585,266 be adopted for the 2011-2012 school year. Be it further RESOLVED that the Property Tax Report Card for the 2011-2012 school year be approved.

Motion was made by Dr. Whitney, seconded by Ms. Mendelson, and carried by a 5-0-0 vote to approve the resolution as presented.
