MINUTES AND BIDS

Minutes of May 15 and 16, 2012 Be it RESOLVED that the Board of Education accept the minutes of its May 15 and 16, 2012 meetings.

ITEMS FOR BOARD ACTION

Adoption of 2012-2013 Recommended Budget and Property Tax Report Card Upon recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, be it RESOLVED that a budget in the amount of \$176,701,579 be adopted for the 2012-2013 school year. Be it further RESOLVED that the Property Tax Report Card for the 2012-13 school year be approved.

Motion was made by Dr. Kerman, seconded by Mrs. Gische and carried by a 6-0-0 vote to approve the resolution as modified.

Background/Rationale:

This budget honors contractual arrangements and anticipated expenditures for the 2012-2013 school year. The adoption of this budget would increase expenditures by 1.2% and has an estimated tax levy of \$131,738,562. This will represent an increase of 2.99% which is the Statutory Cap.

Notice of Public Hearing, Budget Revote 2012-2013 WHEREAS, the State of New York has scheduled a special meeting for the purpose of conducting a budget revote on Tuesday, June 19, 2012,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education designates June 19, 2012 as the revote date and hereby schedules a Public Hearing on Tuesday, June 12, 2012,

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Education hereby authorizes the District Clerk to prepare and publish a Notice of such hearing and revote in substantially the format attached hereto on the designated dates below.

May 31 and June 1, 2012 June 7 and 8, 2012 June 14 and 15, 2012

Motion was made by Dr. Kerman, seconded by Mrs. Gische and carried by a 6-0-0 vote to approve the resolution as presented.

Background/Rationale:

June 19, 2012 has been established as the uniform budget revote date for New York school districts. In accordance with legislation, the Notice of Meeting must be published once each week within the two (2) weeks before the revote, with the first publication being at least fourteen (14) days prior to the revote.
