Retainer Agreement Upon recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, be it

RESOLVED, that the Three Village Central School District hereby retains the law firm of Bond Schoeneck & King, PLLC to challenge the Tax Cap law and its requirements that the Cap may only be pierced by a sixy(60%) percent majority, and be it further

RESOLVED that the Retainer Agreement with Bond Schoeneck & King, PLLC shall provide for a cap on its hourly rate at \$245.00 per hour for partners, \$185.00 per hour for associates and a cop on its total fees of \$15,000.00, provided that at least nine other school districts join in the litigation. If nine other school districts do not join in the litigation, Bond Schoeneck & King is not required to commence the lawsuit.

Motion to Rescind Acceptance of Resignation WHEREAS, on March 13, 2012, the Board of Education voted to accept the resignation for retirement purposes of the employee on the attached Confidential Schedule "A" and named in executive session effective June 30, 2012;

WHEREAS no action has been taken to date as a result of the Board's original vote;

RESOLVED, the Board of Education hereby rescinds its vote of March 13, 2012 regarding the resignation of the employee on the attached Confidential Schedule "A" and named in executive session.

Motion was made by Dr. Kerman, seconded by Mrs. Gische, abstention Mr. Diviney, and carried by a 6-0-1 vote to approve the resolution as presented.

Motion to Accept Hearing Officer's Opinion and Award WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 3020-a of the New York State Education Law, the Board of Education found probable cause to prefer Charges against a tenured teacher; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 3020-a, a disciplinary hearing was held under State Education Department Case No. 14,896 before a designated Hearing Officer whereat there was full and fair disclosure of the nature of the case against the tenured teacher and a full and fair opportunity for the teacher to present a defense; and

WHEREAS, at the conclusion of the disciplinary hearing, the Hearing Officer rendered a written Opinion & Award setting forth findings of fact on each Charge and stating the penalty to be imposed; and

WHEREAS, the Hearing Officer found the teacher guilty of each Charge, including Conduct Unbecoming, Neglect of Duty, Insubordination and Endangering the Health, Safety & Welfare of a Student and determined that a penalty of termination should be imposed;

WHEREAS, subdivision 4 of Section 3020-a of the Education Law requires the Board of Education to implement the decision of the Hearing Officer within fifteen (15) days after receipt of the Hearing Officer's decision; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, the Board of Education hereby accepts the decision of the Hearing Officer and terminates the employment of the teacher set forth on the attached Confidential Schedule "A", effective immediately; and, be it further

RESOLVED, the Board directs the Superintendent of Schools to take such other actions as deemed appropriate to advise said teacher of the Hearing Officer's decision and the Board's acceptance of the same.

Motion was made by Dr. Kerman, seconded by Mrs. Gische, abstention Mr. Diviney, and carried by a 6-0-1 vote to approve the resolution as presented.

WHEREAS, the Board of Education hereby deems it necessary to seek judicial review of and/or challenge the requirements of the New York State Education Department and New York Commissioner of Education with respect to the Annual Professional Performance Review of teachers and principals;
