Attendance and Enrollment -Students Mrs. Pedisich presented the Attendance and Enrollment – Students Report.

The cumulative student attendance for September 2008 through December 2008 was 96.4% which reflects a slight increase from 2007-08.

Student enrollment as of September 2008 was 7737. This is a decrease of 97 students from the September 2007 enrollment of 7834. This decrease reflects 24 less elementary students and 73 less secondary students.

Resolution in Support of Local Government Efficiency Grant Applications WHEREAS, the Three Village Central School District Board of Education believes that expanded availability of shared services and the functional consolidation of certain school district operations will result in greater efficiency and cost-effectiveness; and

WHEREAS, the Suffolk County School Superintendents Association, the Nassau-Suffolk School Boards Association, Suffolk County Government, Eastern Suffolk BOCES, and Western Suffolk BOCES have engaged in discussions regarding the expansion of shared services and functional consolidation amongst Suffolk County school districts; and

WHEREAS, the state has made Local Government Efficiency Grants available to school districts to promote the expansion of shared services; and

WHEREAS, three grant applications are being submitted to solicit funding for the study and establishment of cost-effective shares services to be introduced by Suffolk County school districts; and

WHEREAS, the areas to be studied with the grant funding include the expansion of regional non-public school transportation services (Lead Educational Agencies: Connetquot UFSD; Eastern Suffolk BOCES; Western Suffolk BOCES), the establishment of a countywide school employee health insurance plan (Lead Educational Agencies: Lindenhurst UFSD; Eastern Suffolk BOCES; Western Suffolk BOCES), and the introduction of a shared school purchasing office which will serve as a pilot (Lead Educational Agency: Hampton Bays UFSD); and

WHEREAS, all three of these areas to be studied offer potential savings for all school districts in Suffolk County:

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Three Village Central School District Board of Education supports the application of the Connetquot UFSD, Lindenhurst UFSD, and Hampton Bays UFSD for funding for the New York State Local Government Efficiency Grant Program in order to assure that new cost-effective services options are available to Suffolk County school districts.

Authorization for Shared Municipal Services General Efficiency Planning Grant: A Brookhaven Town-wide Athletic Needs Assessment Whereas, the Board of Three Village Central School District fully supports intermunicipal initiatives to enhance services and reduce costs, and

Whereas, the Three Village Central School District, located within the geographical boundaries of the Town of Brookhaven, has determined that the cost of providing athletic services and activities has risen and will continue to rise, and

Whereas, the Town of Brookhaven can provide grant writing, coordination and financial oversight services, and

Whereas, the Three Village Central School District authorizes the Town of Brookhaven to submit an application for a General Efficiency Planning Grant under the Local Government Efficiency Grant Program, 2008 - 2009, State of New York, Department of State.
