The Course: This is a 1 year course that will culminate with an Algebra II final exam which will be given in June. There will also be a midterm exam. The topics of study this year will be:

- Algebraic Operations
- Functions and Relations
- Types of Functions
- Composition and Inverse Functions
- Transformations of Functions
- Imaginary and Complex Functions
- Probability and Statistics
- Sequences and Series

Homework: Is generally given 3-4 times per week. You will start with a homework grade of 100 which will represent 10% of your grade. For each missing homework assignment, 10 points will be deducted from your HW grade. For each partially completed homework, 5 points will be deducted from your HW grade. No credit for late homeworks.....sorry ☹.

Tests and Quizzes: Represent 90% of your quarterly grade. They are usually given at the end of a unit and count 100 points. Make-up exams are generally **not** given so please make sure to prepare well in advance. If you are absent on the day of an exam, you will be expected to take the exam the day you come back to school. If you are absent during instructional days, reasonable time will be given for you to make up the work you missed before the test. Generally, the day before an exam is a review session for practice problems and Q & A. Quizzes are given more frequently and generally count between 20 – 50 points.
